## **CAMPING REGULATIONS**

The following regulations are to ensure the orderly placement of trailers, campers, tents and motor homes for the week of the Queens County Fair in Caledonia, Queens County. This effort and camper co-operation, is required to maintain maximum capacity within regulations for fire and public safety.

1. **Campers will be permitted to park starting Saturday, September 16th at noon. The**

**Trailer Registration will be included with Entry Packages.**

2. No campers are to be left on the grounds or set up without an attendant designated by the Board of Directors present, except those belonging to Directors who are there to work and who have previously been assigned sites.

3. Returning campers will be assigned the site used in previous years unless otherwise requested. In that case, the camper will be assigned a site to be designated by the parking attendant.

4. **CAMPING FEES MUST BE PAID PRIOR TO PARKING. The attendant will not be accepting camping fees so you will be required to show a paid receipt before you are permitted to park . Anyone who chooses to prepay with your entry will be required to pick up your receipt at the Westfield Gate before proceeding. All others will be required to stop and pay the camping fees before proceeding to the camping area.**

5. Exhibitors Fees - \$75.00 per week

6. Non-Exhibitors fees - \$20.00 per night

7. Canopies may not be able to be used, dependant on space available will be authorized at the discretion of the attendant.

8. Water connections to be secured to prevent leaking (prevent strain on the water conditioning system).

9. It is recommended by the Queens County Fair that all Recreational Vehicles and Campers be equipped with a working fire extinguisher.

10. **Campers are requested to keep their site free of litter and please place garbage in the receptacles provided in the camping area for early morning pick-up. You are requested to leave your site free of garbage as well as any other items when leaving the grounds at the end of the week. Also, you are requested not to place any items in the compost bins which should be placed in garbage cans.**

11. Only one vehicle will be allowed per camper and it will be registered to the campsite.

**PLEASE CHECK WITH OFFICE BEFORE SELLING ITEMS AT A CAMPSITE - WE MAY REQUIRE YOU BE LISTED AS A VENDOR**

**PLEASE CHECK WITH PARKING ATTENDANTS BEFORE PARKING LIVESTOCK TRAILERS AS SPECIFIC AREAS HAVE BEEN ASSIGNED FOR THAT PURPOSE-DEPENDANT ON WHICH BARN YOU ARE ASSIGNED. DUE TO A SHORTAGE OF PARKING SPACE –ONLY ONE PARKING PASS PER CAMPER WILL BE AVAILABLE NO AVAILABLE PARKING IN OTHER AREAS ON THE GROUNDS –ANY VEHICLE NOT DISPLAYING A PARKING PERMIT WILL BE REMOVED AT THE OWNERS EXPENSE**

**DOG REGULATIONS: DUE TO INCIDENTS WHICH HAVE LEFT SEVERAL PEOPLE SEVERELY INJURED AT OTHER VENUES YOU ARE REQUIRED TO KEEP YOUR DOGS AT YOUR CAMPSITE AS NO DOGS ARE ALLOWED IN PUBLIC AREAS. ## GENERAL LIVESTOCK REGULATIONS

1. Horses, cattle and other livestock will be received on Saturday, September 16, providing Teamsters are staying on site.. Unavoidable delays will be dealt with at the discretion of the appropriate committee.
2. The Fair grounds will be open to the public Tuesday through Saturday - 8 a.m. to 11 p.m.
3. No cattle of any breed under 3 months of age shall be allowed to compete for prizes.
4. Pedigrees of all purebred animals over one year of age shall be shown at the time of judging. For purebred animals under one year of age the name and number of sire and dame shall be submitted in writing at the time of judging. Grade animals are the progeny of a purebred sire.
5. **Animals low in flesh or otherwise inferior character, unworthy of a place in exhibition, will not be admitted under any circumstances.**
6. All livestock entries shall be received by the date as shown in the prize books, on forms which are supplied by the Fair and are required to be completed with contact information and registration for livestock and all class entries .
7. Safety of Exhibits: though the Association will take reasonable precaution to insure the safety of articles sent or brought to the exhibition, yet it must be definitely understood that the owner themselves must assume all risk. Should any article be accidentally injured, lost or stolen the association will give all the assistance in its power toward recovery
8. All livestock must be shown in the ring unless otherwise specified. In estimating the value of livestock the judges will take into consideration where animals of different ages are competing against each other.
9. No animal or article can compete in more than one class or in more than one section of the same class except as a herd.
10. No reward or money prize not offered in the list will be paid except it be highly recommended by the Committee and Judge.
11. It does not follow that because a prize is offered for any particular animal or article, that it must be awarded unless there is proper competition or unless the exhibit is of sufficient merit to warrant the award being made.
12. Exhibitors can ascertain from the Superintendent in charge of several departments, when the judge will examine their exhibits. No complaint based upon the statement that Judges overlook animals or articles will therefore be entertained by the executives.
13. Livestock for competition or exhibit shall not be removed from the grounds before 9 p.m. the closing day of the Exhibition.
14. Exhibitors must supply proper fastenings for safety securing the animals in stalls. The Committee will not be responsible for any injury or accident to any animal during the time of the Exhibition or on the Exhibition grounds.
15. Five members of the general committee shall form a quorum for the transaction of business.
16. Any Exhibitor infringing any of the regulations shall forfeit all or any of the prizes that may have been awarded to him.
17. Prize Colors: 1<sup>st</sup> - Red 2<sup>nd</sup> - Blue 3<sup>rd</sup> - White 4<sup>th</sup> - Green
18. No person shall be allowed to interfere with the Judges while in the discharge of their duties. Exhibitors so interfering will forfeit their right to any premium to which they might otherwise be entitled. This rule is strictly enforced.

19. Prize money not paid out immediately following the class will be paid during the two week period following the closing of the fair, by cheque, through the mail. These cheques are to be cashed by the end of November. Exhibitors are urged to have their prize accounts checked at the fair office the day following the close of the Fair.

20. All hauling contests will be judged on a percentage basis unless otherwise stated.

21. Try as we may, we cannot always avoid mistakes, but we can and will cheerfully correct them. Please call our attention to our mistakes.

## **EXHIBITOR & OPEN OX PULLING RULES**

1. This will be a Hook-on and Stay-on Pull and Classes will be split as evenly as possible.
2. All Teamsters will draw for placings.
3. The rails will be nine (9) feet apart and made out of 2x4 or fire hoses.
4. First start will be a free start.
5. Once a team is hooked to the drag, after the free start, it must stay inside the rails, one full front foot outside the rail will constitute elimination
6. Load must be moved three (3) feet in any one of three starts.
7. Teams must remain hooked to the drag between starts.
8. Team has three (3) attempts to hook drag. Failure to do so will result in elimination.
9. Team has fifteen minutes to complete pull from the time the drag is set and announcer has notified the teamster. Ample warning will be given.
10. **No cruelty of any kind will be tolerated. Light use of a whip is permitted, no use of butt end of whip, and lash kept in hand at all times, one warning will be issued if second warning is necessary it will result in elimination. Judge's decision is final.**
11. Maximun weight added per start is 1200 lbs.
12. Winning placings will be decided on percentage basis.
13. Any Ties for Heaviest Load will be decided by measurement in inches successfully pulled on last load.
