NOTE CHANGES TO GATE ADMISSIONS: Bracelets will be used for Day Admissions rather than ink stamps, a different color each day. Season Passes will also be a bracelet rather than a Card Pass. Due to limited parking on grounds each Camper/Exhibitor/Vendor/Staff will be permitted one vehicle pass limited to the vehicle registered. Additional vehicles will be required to park outside to eliminate overcrowding of Fire Lanes and walk ways. DISABLED PARKING IS LIMITED

ALL VEHICLES ENTERING AT WESTFIELD GATE ENTRANCE must display the parking permit which matches the vehicle, the Driver must show his Bracelet. Passengers must be able to show either a Season Bracelet or the bracelet for the day or will be required to walk through to pay admission. The Gate Tender will not be selling Bracelets. When walking in please use the walk way and not the vehicle gate. WALK-IN GATE HWY 8 - Everyone entering is required to keep to the left in front of the Ticket Booth to either purchase a bracelet or show your bracelet of the day. Those exiting the Grounds will keep to their left to allow easy flow of traffic.

These changes are meant to allow for better service at the entrances, allow easier movement about the grounds as well as give the Assoc. a more accurate count of how many are attending as encouraged by the Provincial Assoc. The co-op Gate has to be keep closed due in part to a lack of staff to work that Entrance.
